THE FROGMORE POETRY PRIZE 2009

Announcement of the result of the Frogmore Poetry Prize for 2009, sponsored by the Frogmore Foundation and adjudicated by Robert Seatter.

The Frogmore Poetry Prize for 2009 is awarded to **Howard Wright** of Portadown, County Armagh for his poem DOG DAY. He receives the sum of two hundred guineas and a two-year subscription to *The Frogmore Papers*.

The first runner-up is **Liz Crosby** of Heacham, Norfolk for her poem FOR I WILL CONSIDER MY NEW MOBILE. She receives the sum of seventy-five guineas and a year's subscription to *The Frogmore Papers*.
