- Poems must be your own original work and may be on any subject. They must be typed or neatly hand-written on A4 paper, and **not** longer than 50 lines. Each poem must be on a separate sheet of paper which must not bear your name or any other form of identification.
- 4. On the entry form or a separate sheet of paper, you should give your name and address and the title(s) of the poem(s) submitted. Please tell us where you heard about the competition. **Sonnets** to be considered for **The Ware Sonnet Prize** should be marked with an "S" in the top right hand corner. Sonnets should be no longer than 14 lines. They will also be considered for the main competition.
- Any number of poems may be submitted on payment of the appropriate fee which is £4 per poem, £12 for 4 poems, and £3 thereafter in the same submission. Cheques and Postal Orders (in sterling only) should be made payable to WARE POETS COMPETITION.
- 6. For confirmation of receipt of entry if required, please enclose a stamped addressed envelope marked RECEIPT. For the results sheet, enclose SAE marked RESULTS.
- 7. We regret that we are unable to return poems, or amend them after entry.
- The closing date is **30th April 2013;** results will be sent out in mid-June. An informal prize-giving ceremony and reading will be held at Ware Arts Centre on Friday, 5th July, 2013.
- 9. Copyright remains with the authors but Ware Poets reserve the right to print winning and shortlisted poems in the Competition Anthology.
- Entrants in the competition will be deemed to have accepted these conditions of entry. The adjudicator's decision will be final; no correspondence can be entered into.
